

Md Alamgir Hossain, Scientific Officer, Environmental Oceanography & Climate Division, BORI participated in the saic tsunami buoy maintenance cruise in the Bay of Bengal and Arabian sea onboard ORV Sagar Nidhi from 16 September to 18 October 2023. During the cruise, he participated in the deployment and retrieval of SAIC Tsunami buoys, Argo floats, and sea gliders.
